
# Did you know that 78% of IT decision makers believe their organisation is already digitally mature?

For our recent insights report, 'Information Management on the Front Line', we carried out a comprehensive survey of ITDMs across Europe to understand how organisations were using technology to better manage the movement of information – from internal workflows to customer data.

It was clear that the majority of ITDMs feel their organisation is digitally mature. However, when we asked about a range of different digital and automated capabilities, many hadn't yet adopted some of the more accessible information management capabilities on offer, such as putting document access restrictions in place to support better information security. When looking at more sophisticated capabilities such as automating customer communications processes, less than a third of ITDMs had already implemented it.
