Uni-Tankers A/S, a Danishowned tanker shipping company specialized in transporting liquid chemicals and oil, have successfully achieved great savings and improved efficiency by implementing Canon printers on their five offices and aboard the shipping company's 16 owned tankers.

solution, uniFLOW. Today, Uni-Tankers use the latest series of Canon's imageRUNNER ADVANCE multifunction printers, the imageRUNNER ADVANCE DX C5800, on all their offices.

"We use Canon printers and uniFLOW, as they give our employees the required flexibility and efficiency. At the same time, the Follow-me print solution gives added security, as the prints follow the user and not the printer. This has resulted in a significant decrease in misprints, which in turn benefits the environment and reduces supply costs," says Michael Hust about the current solution. A solution so effective that it has been expanded to also include the shipping company's own tankers.

When a partnership becomes a 360-degree solution

In the view of the positive experiences from their successful office solution, Uni-Tankers decided to extend the collaboration and chose a similar solution for the shipping company's own vessels. "Following the COVID-19 pandemic, our previous partner faced challenges delivering new devices, so we had to find a new set-up to maintain the necessary efficiency on board," explains Michael Hust. In cooperation with Officepilot, they came up with a solution which includes a total of 62 Canon imageRUNNER ADVANCE DX C257 printers that have been installed on the



shipping company's 16 owned tankers.

This has resulted in great savings for Uni-Tankers. The amount of toner used has been reduced significantly as they can now print more with the same amount of toner resulting in expected savings of around DKK 500,000 over the next four years. The printers' robustness, quality, and reliability has given Uni-Tankers a dependable and future-proof setup. But, most importantly, the reduced amount of toner used is a win for the environment.
